### Child Care Development Center

### ACE Tutoring

The **Children's Home of Virginia Baptists** is proud to debut its newest community program. ACE (Active Community for Education) focuses on adolescents and teenagers up to their senior year of high school. An individualized plan and program is created based on each student's skill gap, goals, grades and study habits, while placing emphasis on specific areas needing the most improvement. Workshops, Seminars and additional training will be provided regularly for Specific test preparation such as SOL's or other state based testing, ACT's and SAT's. Tutoring for Math, Reading and Writing will be available daily. Writing Laboratories and Literacy Programs are also available.
